How the story begins!

When Rev. Austin Phiri, chaplain at CT Hospice and Yale New Haven Hospital St. Raphael Campus, was asked about living in Chikwawa District Malawi, he shared about the difficulties of lack of basic necessities and clean water. As his story unfolded, it melted our hearts and wrung our souls calling us to action.

Farming Family Study

Women do the farming; men are off working in large cities. A family usually consists of six children or more, live in huts and cook over an open fire.

Twice a day women and children travel a long distance to water holes filling Gerry cans for family use. The water must be boiled for cooking, bathing, and drinking.

The available water collected from shallow holes is unhealthy and contaminated with water borne diseases.

The land is farmed with hand-held tools and is often drought-stricken. Fields dry up and crops die. Hence the need for deep water wells to provide sustainable clean water for family use and irrigation.
